In view of the directions issued by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, vide order dated 04.07.2024, in the matter of *Matloob Ahmed Vs. IICC*; CS(OS) 331/2023; I.A. No. 32251/2024 regarding facility of E-Voting for outstation and NRI members, all contestants were invited on 13.07.2024 to hear their views regarding the voting methodology to be adopted in the upcoming elections. Thereafter, having considered the matter in detail, the undersigned issues the directions as under:


1. All NRI voters shall be provided the facility of E-Voting only and the Voting Link will be shared through E-Mail.
2. All outstation members, i.e., members not living in Delhi, NOIDA, Greater NOIDA, Faridabad, Gurugram and Ghaziabad, shall be sent postal ballots in physical form, by default.
3. In case, any outstation member wishes to avail the facility of the E-Voting, such member shall express his/her desire to vote through E-Voting by sending an e-mail at: [observer@iiccentre.com](mailto:observer@iiccentre.com) or by WhatsApp message at mobile no. +91 99994 44500 by 20<sup>th</sup> July 2024.
4. Members availing of the E-Voting facility shall ensure that their email ids and/or mobile numbers are duly updated by 20<sup>th</sup> July, 2024.
5. In cases, where multiple members have provided a single mobile number, such members are requested to provide separate mobile numbers for each member, so that the E-Voting link may be sent to them.
6. E-Voting will be open to eligible members/voters from 10.00 am on 8<sup>th</sup> August, 2024 to 05.00 pm on 11<sup>th</sup> August, 2024.

7. In case of outstation members, who do not opt for E-Voting, the physical ballot papers shall be dispatched by registered/speed post on 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2024.
8. Members may kindly note that the last date for receipt of the duly marked postal ballots through registered A/D or Speed Post shall be during working hours on 10<sup>th</sup> August, 2024.
9. For all members residing in Delhi, NOIDA, Greater NOIDA, Faridabad, Gurugram and Ghaziabad, physical voting shall take place at IICC, Lodhi Road, New Delhi on 11<sup>th</sup> August 2024.
10. Counting of votes shall take place on 12<sup>th</sup> August, 2024.
