- 5. In cases, where multiple members have provided a single mobile number, such members are requested to provide separate mobile numbers for each member, so that the E-Voting link may be sent to them.
- E-Voting will be open to eligible members/voters from 10.00 am on 8<sup>th</sup>
  August, 2024 to 05.00 pm on 11<sup>th</sup> August, 2024.
